Medicare rebate for general psychological therapy sessions

You will be able to claim a rebate from Medicare for individual therapy if your doctor has referred you with a Mental Health Care Plan, or if you are referred by a Psychiatrist or Paediatrician. The current rebate (2020) is \$77.10 each session, for up to 20 sessions per calendar year.
